It was voted to have the December meeting one week early on Dec. 19 (to be confirmed in the Dec. newsletter).

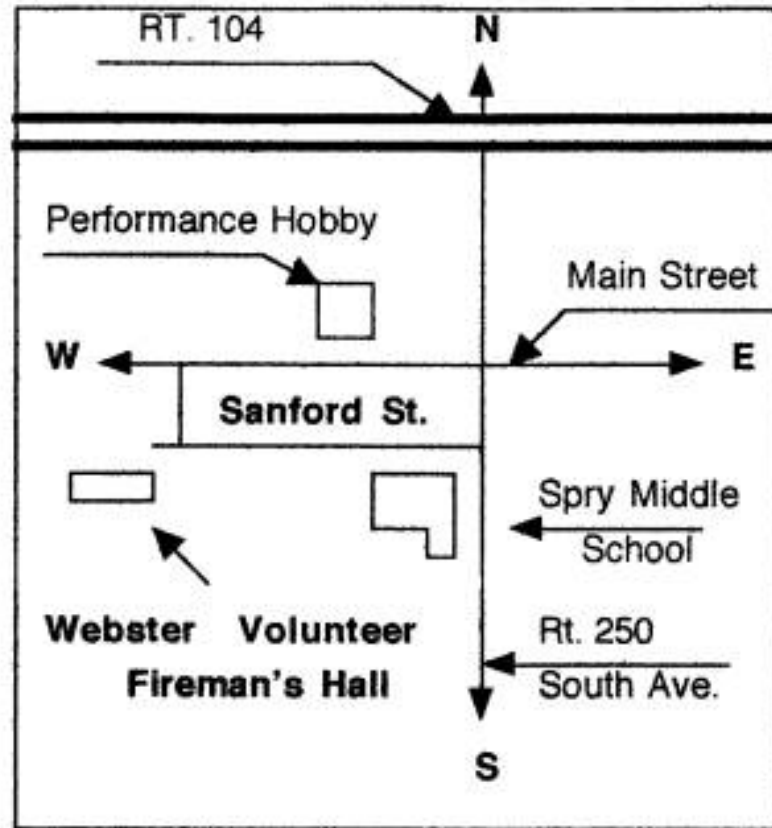
